

custom fabric luggage tags

WHAT YOU NEED:

for one luggage tag:

- 6" x 8" piece of fabric for tag
- 1 1/2" x 12" piece of fabric for strap
- 6" x 8" piece of fusible interfacing
- 2 7/8" x 3 1/2" piece of vinyl



WHAT YOU DO:

All seam allowances are 1/4" unless instructed differently.

1. Using pattern, cut out 2 pieces from fabric and 2 pieces from interfacing. Fuse interfacing to back of fabric pieces.
2. Fold strap in half lengthwise and press. Turn raw edges in to center and press again. Topstitch close to both long sides.
3. Fold strap in half and place raw edges on point of one luggage tag (with looped end toward bottom of tag). Stitch to secure across raw edges of strap. Place both luggage tags right sides together and stitch, leaving an opening on one side to turn. Clip corners and turn right sides out. Press.
4. Place piece of vinyl over the tag, aligning edges, and stitch in place around entire luggage tag. This will enclose 3 of the sides of vinyl and close up the opening you left for turning. It is helpful to have a teflon foot for your machine to keep the vinyl from sticking to your machine's presser foot.

Place a business card or one of the templates provided with this pattern. You can be so creative with these and surely, no one will have the same tags as you again! It will be easy to identify your luggage while expressing your own personal style!
